



The pollinators of the Aegean: biodiversity and threats

The project *POL-AEGIS (The pollinators of the Aegean: biodiversity and threats)* was concluded successfully on 30/11/2015. Through an extensive and systematic fieldwork, a substantial number of deliverables and infrastructures were generated. They include knowledge on pollinator biodiversity (ecological, genetic) in the Aegean Archipelago; the threats these pollinators face, along with a baseline for their future monitoring and for creating a Red Data Book; human taxonomic capital for the pollinators of the country; *Taxonomic keys* of different pollinator groups; the *Atlas of the hoverflies of Greece*; and the *Melissotheque of the Aegean*.
